

# How to use a Leap Card on Dublin Bus services?

December 2011

When using your Leap Card on Dublin Bus for short (1 –3 stages), medium (4 –7 stages), long (8–13 stages) or City Centre journeys:

1. Hold your Leap Card to the target on the driver's ticket machine, as shown here ►
2. Tell the driver your destination.
3. The correct fare will be deducted from your Travel Credit.



For longer journeys (over 13 stages & Xpresso):

1. Please use the Leap Card Validator on the right hand side as you enter the bus as shown here ►
2. The flat fare will be deducted from your Travel Credit.

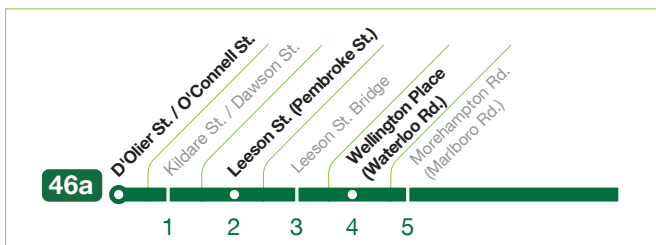


## Please Note:

1. No paper ticket is issued for a single Leap Card transaction.
2. If you wish to pay using your Leap Card for a second passenger, please ask the driver who will deduct both fares and issue the second passenger a valid paper ticket for travel and inspection.

## Stage Information

Your fare is calculated by the number of stages you cross on your journey. See Route 46a example below.



In the example above a customer travelling from D'Olier Street to Morehampton Road (Marlboro Road) has travelled 5 stages.

### Please Note:

To avail of the flat fare, simply present your Leap Card to the Validator on the right hand side as you enter the bus.

If you also wish to pay for a second passenger, please purchase from driver.

A transaction made in error can be cancelled by your driver at the time of purchase only.
