

Environmental Management System Statement



Bus Átha Cliath - Dublin Bus is the largest public transport provider for the Greater Dublin Area. Dublin Bus aims to provide a safe, secure, reliable, efficient, and accessible bus service to its customers. Dublin Bus has a responsibility to minimise, as far as is practicable, its resource consumption and impact on the environment. As part of the organisation's commitment to best environmental practices and sustainability, Dublin Bus will allocate resources to maintain and improve the environmental performance of its employees, vehicles, buildings, and equipment.

Dublin Bus is committed as part of this environmental statement to:

- Operate under our Direct Award Public Service Contract requirements with the National Transport Authority and the international standard EN ISO 14001:2015 (Environmental Management System) to attain and retain the contract and the recognised accreditation.
- Seek to invest in environmentally friendly and sustainable technology when procuring replacement vehicles and equipment.
- Reduce emissions and comply with applicable environmental legislation.
- Include consideration of environmental issues in business strategies and initiatives.
- Ensure that the protection of the environment is embedded in the company's culture.
- Prevent pollution, reduce waste, and minimise the consumption of resources.
- Educate, train, and motivate employees to carry out tasks in an environmentally responsible manner and ensure that a continuous improvement ethos exists in the organisation to increase environmental performance.
- Utilise and monitor environmental KPIs (Key Performance Indicators), where applicable, to demonstrate performance, identify areas for improvement and provide a framework for the development of objectives and targets.
- Welcome feedback from interested parties relating to possible improvements of environmental systems.
- Meet all applicable legal, regulatory and other relevant requirements.
- Encourage environmental conservation amongst suppliers and contractors through the use of sustainable procurement where possible.
- The Dublin Bus Executive Team shall, at regular intervals, check that the company's environmental statement and objectives are being observed and that the Environmental Management Programme is working properly.

This shall include an evaluation of environmental KPIs. The statement applies to all employees throughout the organisation on all premises. The statement will be communicated to employees and be available to the public through selected media.
